



## **MEDIA ALERT**

**What:** Metropolitan handgun owners are turning up in significant numbers to surrender handguns as part of the handgun buyback, now being held in the metropolitan area.

Queues are up to 9 hours long with forecasts of adverse weather, and similar queues reported in buyback centres in regional centres in recent weeks. (\*Photo Opp\*)

Many clubs are becoming unviable as the impact of the buyback on their ability to conduct international events is much greater than intended by the State and Federal Governments.

**Who:** Sebastian Ziccone, President of the CFCV will be there to surrender handgun items that he can no longer use, on Friday 10 October. He will form part of the queue and comment on the impact that the buyback is having on the international shooting sports.

**When:** **Friday 10 October.** Sebastian will line up from **8 am** and is expected to be there until he is processed.
