



## **MEDIA ALERT**

**What:** The handgun buyback finishes on Wednesday 31 December, and shooters are still turning up in significant numbers to surrender banned handguns.

CFCV has been advised of queues of up to 60 shooters this week, with potentially hundreds of other shooters either unable to be processed or meet the Government's deadline. Queues have been up to 12 hours long in what is now becoming the hottest part of the year (\*Photo Opp\*)

**Where:** Melbourne Handgun Buyback Static Centre, 79 B & C Atherton Road, Oakleigh, Melways ref 69 G7.

**When:** **Wednesday 31 December.** CFCV has been advised the buyback centre will close at 1pm – however it is possible the centre will remain open later to deal with unprocessed handguns. It is likely those who turn up before the expected close at midnight will be turned away.
