The Combined Firearms Council of Victoria runs election campaigns to protect the shooting sports.

Successful outcomes of political action to date include:

- the retention of the handgun shooting sports;
- the decision to have a 2009 duck shooting season;
- improving the efficiency of the Firearms Registry for the user;
- the reinstatement of the Firearms Consultative Committee; and
- stopping the Greens taking control of the Upper House of state parliament following the 2006 state election.

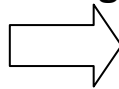
Our campaigns have involved placing full page ads in the major metropolitan and country newspapers and conducting direct mail-outs to shooters in key electorates.
